Social Studies: Me and My Home

- Rainbow Writing first requires using pencil to print the sight words. Next go over top of the pencil many times with various colours.
- The next few pages of the social studies booklet asks for labelled pictures and sentences.
- Word shapes requires students to study the sight words and recognize tall and hanging letters to fit them in the correct boxes.
- Final page is a word search.

Science: Energy and Control

- If you have access to internet a helpful video can be found on Brainpop Jr called Energy Sources. (Log in: blizzardnu password: bakerlake)
- Discuss various sources of light energy (fire, electricity, sun) and then illustrate and label 3 sources.

Math: Addition and Subtraction

- Colour Patterns worksheet provides an example at the top and asks for the squares to be coloured in a pattern, then to write a number sentence. A number sentence, for example, looks like this: $5+5=10$ or $6+4=10$

English Language Arts: Identify all alphabet letters by name and sound, use knowledge of letters sounds and words to read and write simple text, reading comprehension, recognize high frequency words, contractions, apply knowledge of digraphs vowel patterns and blends to write new words

- Yellow Journal Entry: Write two or more sentences describing some things you are doing to have fun outside?
- Read the story My Heart Fills with Happiness to your child (Note: it is a bilingual story of English and Cree)

Comprehension questions to ask afterwards:

- What was the story mostly about?
- What does the story remind you of?
- How was the main character feeling in the book?
- Why do you think the author titled the book: My Heart Fills with Happiness?
- What did you like and dislike about the book?
- What did you like or dislike about the illustrations?
